See supporting documents indicating with a class size of 15 (@\$1,400 per student) the county should net well in excess of \$12,000.

We need a motion:

To approve the purchase of all needed Advance EMT Training books, testing validating and course uniform for up to 15 students estimated to be approximately \$8,600.00 and to set tuition at \$1,400.00 per student.

Spencer County EMS has completed upgrading our TEI (Training Education Institution) which allows us to teach Certificate based programs (AEMT, EMT or EMR) to the general public.

We have opened enrollment for an Advanced EMT Course beginning November 1st and running approx... 6 months. This course is open to any current EMT in the Commonwealth of KY.

We will be utilizing the current AAOS (American Academy of Surgeons) Advanced EMT Curriculmn and Prestige EMT Testing for Validated Testing per KBEMS Regulations.

Currently on staff we have 4 instructors licensed through the Kentucky Board of EMS. Okolona Fire will be providing 3 instructors to assist at ZERO cost to the Service.

The course consists of 160hours of classroom and 72 Hours of ride time requiring 10 patient contacts.

Testing will be completed at the end of the course through the National Registry of EMTs.

Tuition is \$1400 dollars per student. This covers Books, Validating Testing and Course Uniform.

Actual breakdown is \$346 per student.

Estimated overtime costs of \$2320.

The Net to the county is estimated to be \$12.482.50

The course liability insurance is covered under KACO Insurance Policies.

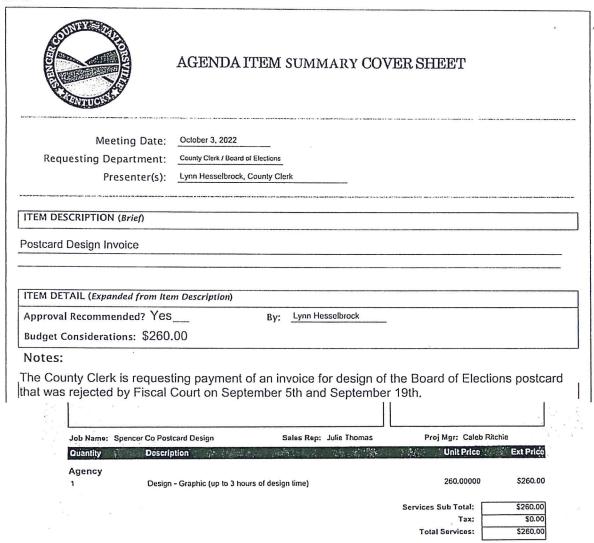
Discussion ensued. Mr. Limpp said that quite a bit of information had been sent out to the Magistrates. Esq. Brewer questioned the overtime costs. Mr. Limpp reported that he was not a state EMS instructor. Robert and Pete were. They were each going to teach a good portion of the class. Okolona Fire requested to teach some of the class. The overtime was an estimate with Robert teaching half of the class and Pete teaching half of the class. The first class will be the first Thursday in November.

- Motion made by Esq. Beaverson, seconded by Esq. Brewer to approve the request by EMS. Roll call vote as follows: "ayes" Esq. Beaverson, Judge Riley, Esq. Travis. "nays" were Esq. J. Moody and Esq. Brewer. Esq. M. Moody was absent. The Judge declared the motion "passed".
 - 2. Invoice for postcard design service- Spencer County Clerk, Lynn Hesselbrock
- Motion made by Esq. Beaverson to pay the invoice. Motion seconded by Esq. Travis.

Discussion ensued. Esq. Travis asked if the Clerk had ordered the design work before it was submitted to Fiscal Court. The Clerk responded that it was. Esq. Travis asked if this was normally something that would be paid out of her office expenses and the Clerk replied that it was an election expense. The Judge requested the Clerk communicate with Bluegrass Communications as he did not think it was three hours of graphic design work. He said it was basically a duplicate of the one she sent out in the Primary. He thought that was an exorbitant amount of money for probably ten minutes of graphic design. The Judge wanted the Clerk to talk to Bluegrass and ask them to waive the charges. Esq. Brewer remarked he thought the Clerk should have come to Court before to get their permission to design the postcard.

Voice vote on the motion as follows: "nays" Judge Riley, Esq. Travis, Esq. J. Moody, Esq. Brewer. "ayes" Esq. Beaverson. Esq. M. Moody was absent. Motion fails. The Clerks asked the Judge if he wanted her to ignore

the invoice and he responded no, they had to pay invoices. He encouraged her to contact Bluegrass and ask them to waive the fees. The Judge said that Fiscal Court should not be responsible for paying this. The Clerk replied that in the August meeting, the Spencer County Board of Elections voted to move forward with sending the postcard, and ask Fiscal Court to pay for them. The Clerk remarked that Department Heads had \$1000.00 cap on spending before bringing it to Fiscal Court, and she remarked that apparently that did not apply to her office, and asked if that was correct. The Judge said he was like Esq. Brewer, the cart was before the horse, running up a bill before getting approval. The Clerk remarked that on every Fiscal Court agenda, there were bills up to \$1000.00 that were not pre-approved by Fiscal Court. The Judge said this was different, it was something the Court rejected. The Clerk said the Court did not reject it until after the editing was done.

I would like to re-lease approximately 100-150 acres for future recreational facility development.

The Judge remarked that he and Stacey Koon had an excellent meeting with the Commissioner of Parks. They leased about 300 acres up there for the purpose of recreation, and sub leased that to the developer of Edgewater Resorts. That did not materialize like anybody had hoped, and there was a problem with the package sewer plant. The previous Court opted to relinquish the leasehold to it, and let it all go back to the Parks. He had gone to Frankfort to ask them if they could re lease 100-150 acres or so. They wanted a formal request from Spencer County. The best way he knew to do that was to put it before the Court and pass a resolution authorizing him as County Judge to make that request from Parks, and they could then go to work on their end. So, he would need a motion to approve the resolution.

Resolution in Support of Re-Leasing Land from Kentucky Department of Parks

Whereas, Spencer County Fiscal Court subleased approximately 300 acres of land from the Kentucky Department of Parks which was leased from and owned by the federal Corp of Engineers for the purpose of developing recreational facilities near Taylorsville Lake; and

Whereas, a portion of that leased land was subleased by Spencer County Fiscal Court to a developer of Edgewater Resorts Cottages; and

Whereas, in 2015 it was discovered that there were significant problems and a lack of proper maintenance of the package sewer processing plant that serviced not only the Edgewater Resort properties, but also Taylorsville Lake State Park as well as Taylorsville Lake Marina which is also leased from the Kentucky Department of Parks to another private owner; and

Whereas, in the best interests of all concerned it was determined then that it would be best for Spencer County Fiscal Court to relinquish our leasehold interest in that land to help facilitate and to allow Kentucky Department of Parks to work directly with the City of Taylorsville to redirect the wastewater from Edgewater Resort, the State Park and Marina into the City of Taylorsville's municipal wastewater treatment lines system; and,
