## Spencer County, Kentucky Ordinance No. 21 Fiscal Year 2007 Series

# An Ordinance to Amend the Spencer County Administrative Code

Whereas, the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Kentucky has adopted the Spencer County Administrative Code, effective January 1, 2007; and

Whereas, the Fiscal Court of Spencer County had determined it necessary to create a new section of the Code to designate and regulate the operations of the Spencer County Dispatch;

**Now, Therefore Be It Ordained** by the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Commonwealth of Kentucky the following items be added as new sections to Chapter 5 *Delivery of County Services* of the Spencer County Administrative Code:

#### SECTION 5.7: Establishment of the Department

- A. Through the letting of a contract for services, the Spencer County Fiscal Court shall assign the duties of the dispatching department to the awarded independent contractor.
- B. Fees for dispatching services shall be provided in accordance with the terms of the bidder's contract and/or negotiations. No other benefit shall be implied except as specifically stated within the written contract.

### SECTION 5.8: <u>Dispatch Operations</u>

- A. Utilizing space provided by and using equipment owned and retained by the Spencer County Fiscal Court, the contractor and his/her employees shall provide the following services:
  - 1. Dispatch for the Spencer County Sheriff's Department
  - 2. Dispatch for the Taylorsville City Police Department
  - Dispatch for Spencer County Emergency Medical Services
    Dispatch for the Spencer County and Taylorsville Fire Departments
  - 5. Dispatch for the Taylorsville Water Department
  - 6. Dispatch for the Kentucky Fish and Wildlife Department
  - 7. Dispatch for the local Kentucky Humane Society office
  - 8. Dispatch for the Kentucky State Police (when they are in Spencer County)
  - 9. Dispatch for the Taylorsville Lake State Park officers
  - 10. Relay dispatches to Shelby County Dispatch for Mt. Eden Fire Department
  - 11. Test emergency equipment (sirens)

## SECTION 5.9: Wrecker Policy/Rotation List

- A. The following are the minimum standards required for a wrecker service provider to be placed on the Spencer County Wrecker Rotation List:
  - 1. All wrecker owners shall own their storage lots and have proper zoning for vehicle storage.
  - 2. All wrecker services must buy a Spencer County Business License each year.
  - 3. All wrecker services must be inspected by the Kentucky State Police and have met all their requirements.
  - 4. All wrecker services must be able to respond to the call within 20 minutes of the received call.
- B. If a wrecker service is unable to respond to 4 calls within a 30-day period, the service may be removed from the Spencer County Wrecker Rotation List.
