Spencer County, Kentucky Ordinance No. 3 Fiscal Year 2005 Series

An Ordinance Relating to the Adoption of a Road onto the County Road System

Whereas, written request has been made to formally adopt roads within the Phase One of the Goebel Crossings subdivision onto the Spencer County Road System, and

Whereas, the roads in question have been inspected and found to meet all current road specifications,

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Commonwealth of Kentucky that the Fiscal Court does hereby adopt onto the Spencer County Road System the following roads for limited maintenance such as snow removal and right-of-way trimming, with official mileage and speed limit as designated:

Nevin Lane, 0.312 mile, 25mph speed limit Andrew Parkway, 0.140 mile, 25mph speed limit Benjamin Blvd, 0.231 mile, 25mph speed limit Madison Court, 0.077 mile, 25mph speed limit Louise Court, 0.075 mile, 25mph speed limit

Be It Further Ordained by the Fiscal Court that the required road bond on these roads (\$41,750.00 total) shall be posted, and shall be held by the Fiscal Court for at least one year after the adoptive date of this ordinance. After the bond is released, the County agrees to accept full maintenance responsibility for these roads.
