**An Ordinance Amending the 911 Addressing Ordinance of April 1991 for the
Implementation and Maintenance of the Spencer County 911 Emergency Response System**

Be It Ordained by Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Kentucky, to amend the 911 Addressing Ordinance sections to read as follows:

1. ~~NEW STRUCTURES AND MOBILE HOMES~~

- ~~(a) All persons, firms, corporations and other legal entities constructing new structures or locating or relocating mobile homes in Spencer County, Kentucky shall from and after this date obtain an Address Notification Form, duly issues by the addressing authority.~~
- ~~(b) Applicants shall apply for the Address Notification Form with the Fiscal Court of Spencer County. The Fiscal Court will furnish the applicant with a copy to present to the United States Post Office.—~~
- ~~(c) Immediately upon the filing of the Address Notification Form, the Fiscal Court shall assign a number and address to the structure. The Fiscal Court shall keep a record of all numbers and addresses assigned.~~

2. POSTING OF DESIGNATED ~~NUMBERS~~ ADDRESSES

The owner or occupant or person in charge of any house, building, mobile home or other structure to which a number has been assigned:

- (a) Shall within 30 days after the receipt of such number or if a structure has an established number affix said number ~~in a conspicuous manner in a conspicuous place.—~~ on the structure on the front side of the structure or at the entrance way to the structure so that the number is visible from the roadway during both the day time and night time. The numbers shall also be of a size and contrasting color so as to be visible from the roadway.
- (b) Shall within 30 days remove any different number which might be mistaken for or confused with the number assigned to said structure by the issuing authority.
- (c) Each principal building or structure shall display the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is located. In case the principal building or structure is occupied by more than one business or family dwelling unit, each separate front entrance ~~may~~ shall display a separate number.
- (d) ~~Numerals indicating the official numbers for each principal building, or each front entrance to such building, shall be posted in a manner as to be legible and distinguishable from the street or road on which the property is located, with numbers applied, of not less than two inches in height.— Mail boxes shall be marked with the house number.~~ Shall clearly display the address on both sides of

the unobstructed mailbox to the property in numerals with a minimum of two (2") inches in height made of reflective material or in a contrasting color.

- (e) ~~If the structure is not visible from the street or road on which it is located and no mail box is beside the driveway leading to the structure, a sign or number post shall be erected to display the number which may be displayed either vertically from the top down or horizontally.~~ In the event that the foregoing requirements of (a) and (d) cannot be satisfied due lack of mailbox or due to no structure being located less than seventy-five (75) feet from the road, the person who owns the property must make alternative arrangements to ensure that the property address is visible from the road including, but not limited to posting the property address on a fence, gate or other apparatus visible from the roadway. This does not authorize any person to violate any provision of the planning and zoning regulations or any other law or regulation.

Be It Further Ordained by the Fiscal Court that the following section be added to the ordinance:

7. PENALTIES.


Failure to comply with any provision of this ordinance, including the provisions requiring the display of an address, is a violation punishable by a fine of up to \$100.

8. EFFECTIVE DATE.


This ordinance shall become effective January 1st, 2010.
