Fiscal Year 2006 Series

An Ordinance Relating to the Adoption of Roads onto the County Road System

Whereas, written request has been made to Spencer County Fiscal Court to formally adopt the roads within Goebel Crossings, phase 2 onto the Spencer County Road System, and

Whereas, the roads in question have been inspected and found to meet all current road specifications,

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Commonwealth of Kentucky that the Fiscal Court does hereby adopt onto the Spencer County Road System the following road for limited maintenance, such as snow removal and right-of-way trimming, with official mileage and speed limit as designated:

Nevin Lane, extended for 1,839.23 feet, 25mph speed limit
Andrew Parkway, extended for 1,126.48 feet, 25mph speed limit
Benjamin Blvd, extended for 864.61 feet, 25mph speed limit
Jane's Way for 1,950.7 feet, 25mph speed limit


Be It Further Ordained by the Fiscal Court that a construction entrance sign be posted at the Nevin Lane main entrance and a passage way be furnished off of Hochstrasser Lane;


Be It Further Ordained by the Fiscal Court that the minimum required road bond on these roads and/or sections of roads (\$34,835 on Nevin Ln, \$10,667 on Andrew Pkwy, \$8,187 on Benjamin Blvd, and \$18,473 on Jane's Way) shall be posted by the developer, and shall be held by the Fiscal Court for at least one year after the adoptive date of this ordinance. After a satisfactory annual inspection and the bond is released, the County agrees to accept full maintenance responsibility for these roads.
