## Spencer County, Kentucky Ordinance No. 7 Fiscal Year 2004 Series

## An Ordinance Relating to the Adoption of a Road onto the County Road System

Whereas, written request has been made to formally adopt the roads within Settler's Point subdivision onto the Spencer County Road System, and

Whereas, the roads in question have been inspected and found to meet all current road specifications,

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Commonwealth of Kentucky that the Court does hereby adopt onto the Spencer County Road System the following roads for limited maintenance such as snow removal and right-of-way trimming, with official mileage and speed limit as designated:

Settler's Point Drive, 0.726 mile (1,240 feet), 25 mph speed limit Cherokee Court, 0.117 mile, 25 mph speed limit Indian Way, 0.500 mile, 25 mph speed limit Frontier Avenue, 0.286 mile, 25 mph speed limit Pioneer Drive, 0.850 mile, 25 mph speed limit Wagon Trail, 0.175 mile, 25 mph speed limit

Be It Further Ordained by the Fiscal Court that the required amount of road bond on these roads will be posted, and shall held by the Court for one year after the adoptive date of this ordinance. After the bond is released, the County agrees to accept full maintenance responsibility for the said roads.
