- A. Opening Prayer
 Esq. Judd led the Court in prayer before Court began.
- Pledge of Allegiance.
 Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag.
- C. Call to order by the County Judge Executive
- D. Roll call by the County Clerk
- E. Approval of minutes from prior Court meeting.

 The County Clerk stated that the Clerk's Office was not charging for copies of the Clerk's Administrative Code. Esq. Moody asked that a notation be made on the minutes that stated the entire quarterly financial report could be found on the County's website.
 - On the motion of Esq. Judd, seconded by Esq. Goodlett, with all members of the Court present voting "Aye", it is hereby ordered to approve the minutes of the October 15th Fiscal Court meeting with corrections being made.
- F. Communications from Citizens ***3 minute limit***

Mr. Lawrence Trageser came before the Court address the County radio issue. Mr. Trageser stated that on August 20, 2012, Fiscal Court approved spending \$620.00 for a radio frequency for the Sheriff's Department. He stated that the new frequency has not been implemented yet, and he asked each Magistrate and the Sheriff to comment about it. There was no response.

Mr. Trageser went on to state that the County has a dispatch that is working very well that has saved the County over \$100,000.00. He said that Bill Karrer and Buddy Stump were trying to circumvent and have the dispatch taken away because in the Judge's mind, the State Police had violated the dispatch contract by not notifying the nearest available unit, citing ten occurrences. Comments from citizens were closed.

G. Communications from the County Judge Executive.

1. County Clerk 2011 audit for 12/1/2012-12/31/2012.

The judge commented that he had received the audit and it was a good audit. There were two citations that were very common in most all the County audits: "segregation of duties" and an issue about charging for notarizing signatures on titles. Both issues were being addressed and the Judge went on to say that the Auditors were present in the office for about one month's time to perform an audit on one month's activity. The cost was to be around \$7,000.00. The Judge thought the time spent and the cost was excessive and he was going to protest the cost to the State Auditor's office.

2. County radios and dispatch.

The Judge explained that Fiscal Court had urged him to call an "emergency situation" to repair the radio system. We have worked hard the last three weeks to fix this situation. Some radios have come in and are currently being programmed. In the interim period of time, I and the City Council tried to negotiate a MOU to put the radios in service and have the equipment installed at the sites where the radio equipment currently is and that is on the water towers that belong to the City of Taylorsville, The first problem we had was it took nearly a day to get permission to get onto the sites to look at the equipment. But we did get past that and I met with the City and agreed to and volunteered to and offered to pay for the City's equipment.

They agreed to that in principle at that meeting and we started to work on a MOU. I put one together. One of the City Commissioners, Fire Chief Nathan Nation presented a MOU.

You have both of those in your packets. The Mayor brought back my MOU and requested that it be strengthened as far as back-up equipment for the City. I agreed and put it in the MOU. He signed it, I signed it; we had an agreement. And then, the City, with the stroke of an eraser, overturned the agreement and said "no". The Judge then said he had been educated on why there had been a clamor for merged government and why people were upset over their water rates "So now, we build our own tower. We will begin to unshackle ourselves from the stranglehold of the City of Taylorsville." He said that a survey done to have the tower erected on County property stated it would cost approximately \$30,000.00. He said "the City will have to pay for their own radios." He said that this had all come to a head at the same time. When he came into office, Sheriff Buddy Stump told him that there were two problems that needed to be addressed. One was the radio system was less than adequate, and the second was that the dispatch by KSP was not being done properly. He went on to say that the problem had been worked on for eighteen months, but after that time, both were still a problem. The Judge stated that on the day Oktoberfest was held, he received a call from Sheriff Stump stating that the KSP had arrived in town and were answering all the dispatch calls, and that no calls were coming into the Sheriff's radios. He said he (the Judge) went into town and met with Sgt. Felder and had a conversation with him. Sgt. Felder stated that he and the Sheriff did not get along. The Judge suggested that the two meet and try to work out their differences.

The Judge said a few days later he contacted Commissioner Rodney Brewer of the KSP and spoke to him about the issue. Commissioner Brewer asked the Judge to contact Captain White to see if the problems could be worked out and if not, to get back to him (the Commissioner). The Judge met with Captain White in the Judge's office and suggested that Captain White meet with the Sheriff to discuss the issues. Several days later, the Sheriff told the Judge that Captain White had not contacted him. The Judge said that ten days later he sent a letter to Captain White and carbon copied the letter to Commissioner Brewer.

Dear Capt. White,

Thank you for visiting with me in my office on Thursday 18 October. I wanted to take a moment here, in this letter, to review some of the issues we covered during that visit.

As you know, I stated that our current Sheriff, Buddy Stump, made two comments, more than eighteen months ago, at a 911 meeting. Sheriff Stump stated that our radio system was little more than worthless and KSP was not dispatching law enforcement correctly. I informed you that I have come to realize that Sheriff Stump was, and is, correct on both points.

On the radio issue, I promised you that, after many efforts to repair the system, we are going to solve the radio problem. I have declared this issue an emergency and we are installing a new digital system that has been tested and proven.

The dispatching issue, however, remains a matter of great concern. I asked that you contact our Sheriff and work out the problems concerning our dispatching contract with KSP. To date, this has not occurred and, I believe, the situation has further deteriorated. As you are aware, this disturbs me greatly as I fear without co-ordinated communications, someone is likely to be needlessly injured or killed.

I am enclosing some recent CAD logs that show up on our MDTs in our Sheriff's cars. Please take a look at these and tell me where the dispatches are for Spencer County be it for State Police, Sheriff's enclosed traffic citations indicate. I know that the State Police are somehow being dispatched as the enclosed traffic citations indicate.

Captain White, the Taxpayers of Spencer County pay Kentucky State Police around \$6,000.00 a month for professional dispatching service. I find the service to be less than professional and it will not continue to be tolerated. As I stated to you, until this issue is resolved, I will sign NO checks for this

I look forward to a quick resolution of this issue.

> The Judge stated that on the day he mailed the above letter, he received a letter from KSP stating that payment for dispatch services for the period of July 1, 2012 through September 30 2012 was due. The letter also stated that the County was being asked to pay in advance for dispatch services for the period of October1, 2012 through December 31, 2012. The letter was signed by Commissioner Rodney Brewer of the Kentucky State Police. The letter stated that Spencer County owed the amount of \$22, 375.00 for each quarter, for a total of \$ 44,750.00. Payment was due within seven days. The Judge commented that the County had been charged for services not yet performed since they were billed through December 31, 2012. The Judge stated that according to the CAD reports, there were no dispatches shown for Spencer County. He summarized that KSP was contracted to dispatch to the Spencer County Sheriff's Office, and that they had not done so, therefore, they were in breach of the contract. He went on to say that he would not sign the check to pay KSP. He said he would not ask Fiscal Court to approve, but neither he nor the Deputy Judge would sign the check. He said that the County Treasurer could sign the check, but again, he would not.

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The Judge said that Esq. Davis had asked him to let Sheriff Melton, of Franklin County, address the Court about their radio system. Sheriff Melton spoke to the Court about the system Franklin County had implemented which was a dual purpose system, which allowed for digital and analog uses. Sheriff Melton said that Franklin County had gone with a Kenwood Next Edge System. The system that Spencer County was looking into was a sister brand to that system. He said that with the narrowband mandate they would have lost about 25% of their coverage. He spoke of the merits of the system, citing security built into it. He also said the cost of the system was about 25% of what a P-25 system would have cost. Sheriff Stump asked Sheriff Melton to comment on their dispatch system. Sheriff Melton said that he was surprised that Spencer County did not have their own dispatch. He said that in Franklin County, they had a joint dispatch system with KSP as a back-up. He commented that every call was documented in a CAD report. He said that the ultimate goal was to protect the first responders.

After Sheriff Melton addressed the Court, the Judge asked if Sheriff Stump had met with Captain White. The Sheriff said that they had met and discussed their issues.

Mr. John Riley asked to comment, and the request was denied. Chief Nathan Nation asked to comment and his request was denied.

The Judge then went on to say that on Friday afternoon he had received an email from Commissioner Nation which said as a result of a special meeting of the Taylorsville City Commission, they wanted Commissioner Nation to set up a special meeting with the 911 committee and Spencer County Fiscal Court to discuss the emergency 911 communication system and the dispatch service. The email went on to say the City Commission wanted Mr. Nation to get a date set for the 911 committee and Fiscal Court to meet. The meeting would take place at the Taylorsville City Hall Annex. The Judge said that there were two options for the meeting to occur.

The first option would be that the first item on the agenda would be an apology by the City Commission to the people of Spencer County for their actions last week. The second option would be "when Hell freezes over." The Judge instructed Commissioner Nation to go back to the Mayor and have him talk with the Judge. Commissioner Nation spoke up "the issue was..." the Judge interjected "no Sir, go back and talk to your Mayor." Esq Moody stated that he thought things were "getting blowed out of proportion over people's egos." Esq. Moody said that there was an agreement here that had been resubmitted, but instead you're making a choice... the Judge said "no, it was not resubmitted, it was submitted at the outset. Esq. Moody went on to say that because of egos "you're wanting to spend \$20,000.00 to \$30,000.00 to build your own tower instead of working with the City over some small little details." The Judge said that he had he had tried to work with the City and the history of working with the City was revealing itself. Esq. Moody said that he thought the City was having difficulty working with the Judge as well. Esq. Moody said that there was difficulty on both sides that needed to be resolved. He said that the Court, in good faith, voted the emergency power to the Judge to resolve the issue. The Judge said that was not correct, he said that the Court had urged him to declare an emergency. He said that is the job of the County Judge, and I did that and that's where we are and I will continue to operate under that law until we fix the radio system. Esq. Moody then made a motion that it was not an emergency situation and the Judge said he could not do that because it was out of order.

Esq. Judd said he wanted to address the apparent hostility between our Sheriff and KSP. He said that the EMS and Fire Departments were working great with dispatch but the law enforcement side is not working properly. He said rather than being hostile, the two sides should be gentlemen and put their heads together and work it out. The Judge said that he had worked for over eighteen months on the issue and things had got better for awhile, but matters were now worse.

Sheriff Stump said that he had tried to work with the KSP but that they had refused to communicate with the Sheriff's Department. He cited a case where a Deputy was on the scene without the knowledge that KSP had also been dispatched. He said it came down to being a safety issue. He said the reason EMS and the Fire Department got along with dispatch was that KSP did not have an EMS unit or a Fire truck. He stated that he was not in competition with KSP; he just wanted to work together with them so the issues of the citizens could be resolved. He went on to explain the benefits of the new digital radio system. He said the County was not going with the P-25 system because it was outdated. He said the County was doing what was necessary to protect the law enforcement personnel. He said he was trying to work with other County and City agencies, but was constantly being thwarted in his efforts. He went on to say the digital system was the best for the County, and that the County needed to act quickly to fix the radio problem before someone was hurt or injured. He cited a liability issue with the current system.

Esq. Judd said he agreed that the law enforcement personnel needed to be protected, but he was concerned about Spencer County's government and the State Police. He said again that the dispatch system worked well except for law enforcement and that the County could not afford to let the Sheriff's Department have its own dispatch system. He said that had not worked in the past. He said that fences needed to be mended to make the program work. He said that there might need to be a joint meeting held to resolve the issues. Esq. Moody said it seemed that the Judge and the Sheriff didn't want KSP in the County. He stated that half the citations in his packet were for "visual observation" occurrences. He said that the people of Spencer County paid for the State Police just like everyone else, and that he expected them to issue citations if they observe them while in the County. The Sheriff said that he agreed "100 percent", and Esq. Moody went on to say that there was a negative attitude. Sheriff Stump said the problem was with communication with KSP. The Judge said that the CAD reports reflect that KSP dispatch was not dispatching to the Spencer County Sheriff's Department.

Esq. Davis asked that former Magistrate, Mr. John Riley, be allowed to speak since he had done a great amount of research on the dispatch issue. The Judge said he would be allowed to speak, but the Judge wanted to make a point first. The Judge said that he was not advocating for Spencer County to do its own dispatch, but that there were dispatch companies around who could fulfill the dispatch duties who did not have "a dog in the fight" as to who got dispatched.

Mr. Riley addressed the Court saying he had been part of a large group of people who had spent many hours on the dispatch issue. He said that he thought everyone in the room was concerned about the law enforcements safety. Mr. Riley said the KSP dispatch personnel were highly trained and that the cost to the County was an advantage to using KSP dispatch. He went on to say he did not think that the Sheriff was being honest with the people in the Courtroom, and the citizens of Spencer County. He said he thought that the Sheriff had a "poor attitude" about KSP even before they had attended a meeting while discussions were ongoing about what system the County would go with. Mr. Riley went on to say that if the Sheriff talked to others the way he had talked to Mr. Riley, there would be problems that could not be resolved. He stated that he knew the Sheriff has talked to KSP in that manner, and that he had no respect for that. Mr. Riley went on to say that the Sheriff "had a problem dealing with the State Police and he was hell bent from the get go to destroy that relationship and to do something". The Sheriff invited Mr. Riley to discuss the issue in his office. Mr. Riley ended his statements. The Judge stated that this had been a long standing problem, and when he signed the contract to renew service with KSP, he thought that there was some light at the end of the tunnel, but matters had gotten worse. He said "forget about the personalities". Mr. Riley said that one of the personalities had not changed, and the Judge called him out of order. Esq. Goodlett said that since the State Police were present, maybe they would like to comment. Captain Chad White addressed the Court and stated that he had not received any complaints from Spencer County until October, when he received a call from the Judge informing him of the problems and asking him to come to the Judge's office to discuss the issues.

Captain White said that they met and had a productive meeting. Captain White said that he told the Judge to let him know if there were problems so that they could be addressed. Captain White also said that he told the Judge to have the Sheriff call him to discuss the problems. Captain White said that he never received a call from the Sheriff. He said that ten days prior he received a letter from the Judge saying conditions had deteriorated. He said he called the Sheriff and they met and had a productive meeting. Captain White said he then spoke with the KSP dispatchers and asked them what they did if they received a 911 call from Spencer County. The dispatchers told them that they dispatched on the County radio to the Sheriff's Department. He asked the dispatcher "do they usually take it?" and the dispatcher said "yes, they do". Captain White then asked the dispatcher "when do you dispatch to the Troopers? He dispatcher responded that they have a County radio, and if they hear the call and they are closer, they will take the call. So her instructions are, she tells the Post Commander, what I think I'm supposed to do is if a 911 call comes in for law enforcement services, I put it out over County radio for them to take. I don't even get on digital radio and check to see if a Trooper is closer, if they are closer than that to hear it, they volunteer to go. He said he could not comment on issues prior to July 1, 2012. He went on to say KSP dispatch worked well in other counties and was economical for Counties. He again said he wanted to know if there was a problem so he could fix it. He said that Spencer County could choose not to contract with KSP, but that they should be paid for services already provided. Esq. Davis asked Captain White what type of system KSP used. Captain White described the System and Esq. Davis said," It's not P-25?" And Captain White said he did not believe it was. County Attorney Hollan asked Captain White when KSP took a 911 call and dispatched to Spencer County if there was a CAD generated and Captain White said yes, each 911 call created a CAD report.

Captain White went on to say that some calls did not generate a CAD report if they were a low priority call, and he gave many examples where there would not be a CAD report. He said that "visual observation" traffic stops would not generate a CAD report. County Attorney Hollan asked Captain White that if a dispatch had come in to a particular Deputy would there be a CAD report. She said that otherwise, how could KSP charge for their services. The Judge explained that KSP charged by the amount of time it took two dispatchers to dispatch to Spencer County. The Judge then went on to say that he had no problem for the earlier quarter that KSP had billed for, but questioned why the County had been billed for services not yet performed. Captain White said that he could not explain the billing process. The Judge then said that he had sent Captain White the citations and CAD reports because the Judge had spent time with the Deputies and they showed him that they had received no CAD reports. Captain White said that he needed to know if there was a 911 call and KSP was dispatched and Spencer County was not notified. He said that there was a good paper trail to follow up. The Judge asked if Post 12 only dispatched for Spencer County and Captain White said "yes" The Judge then asked Captain White if County radio traffic is recorded and Captain White said that it was his understanding that it was not. Esq. Cheek said that he appreciated Esq. Judd's suggestion for a joint meeting. He then asked the Judge if the Court had given him "carte blanche" when an emergency situation was declared. The Judge responded "no", the Court had urged him to declare an emergency situation and he had done so. He said it was his job to make sure that there were funds available to resolve the radio issue. He went on to say that the dispatch issue was separate from the emergency situation, but it was an issue that had to be resolved soon. Esq. Cheek wanted to know what direction the Court was going to go on the issue and the Judge said that it was up to the Court to decide. He went on to say that he was not satisfied with the KSP dispatch, and explained the reasons why, including the issue of communication with the Sheriff's Department. Esq. Moody asked if the Judge thought the situation would be rectified by holding the money hostage, and the Judge replied in the affirmative.

The Judge again said that he would not sign the check for KSP services, but he was not asking the Court to reject payment. Esq. Judd said that Captain White had not received any complaints until October. Esq. Moody said "then that quarter is good." The Judge again said that he would not sign the check. Esq. Goodlett asked the Judge if he thought KSP was trying to resolve the issues, and the Judge responded "I would hope so." The Judge again asked why Spencer County was being billed for services not yet provided.

It was agreed upon to take a ten minute break.

When Court resumed, Esq. Davis spoke saying he had looked into the P-25 system and he quoted several news sources that said the P-25 system was flawed, but that the digital system would only jam with massive amounts of power. He went on to state that he had attended a City Commission meeting where the agenda read "radio communications". He said that they did speak about that, but the agenda should have read "witch hunt on Sheriff Stump and Judge Karrer" because I heard a lot of that.

3. Extension Service vacancies.

The Judge explained that there was one vacancy and two replacements to be filled.



3. Ordinance #6 (2013 series) second reading and adoption

Spencer County, Kentucky Ordinance No. 6 Fiscal Year 2013 Series

An Ordinance to Amend the Spencer County Fiscal Court Administrative Code

Whereas, Kentucky Revised Statute Chapter 68, as amended, was created for the purpose of creating a sound and efficient administration of county government; and

Whereas, on September 7, 2011 the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Kentucky adopted the Spencer County Administrative Code, as Ordinance No. 2 (2012series) pursuant to and as required by KRS Chapter 68; and

Whereas, the Fiscal Court has determined it necessary to amend the Code to reflect changes in personnel;

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Commonwealth of Kentucky that:

Section One. Chapter Three Personnel Administration Plan II Classification Plan is hereby amended to create the job class title of "Enforcement Administrator" as class code 1010(b) with the following additions:

- 1. Add "Pay Grade: Exempt"
- Add "Characteristics of the Class: This position is under direct supervision of the Occupational Tax Administrator. Daily work will be self-directed, involving a high level of independent judgment."
- 3. Add "Essential Job Functions: Assisting the Occupational License Administrator in investigating and enforcing violators of the Business License and Occupational Tax Ordinances, and other county regulations and/or ordinances. Investigating complaints; work with the City and County Attorneys, County Attorney, and Spencer County District and Circuit Courts on court matters, other field investigations or inspections as required to enforce county regulations; answering questions from the public concerning code requirements. To attend Fiscal Court meetings as requested. The employee will perform both general administrative tasks in an office environment along with investigations in the field."
- 4. Add "Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Employee must have the ability to read and interpret regulations. Skills at understanding and using maps are essential. Strong oral and interpersonal skills, including skills at conflict resolution, are imperative. The ability to type and use a computer. Employee must

be able to operate a motor vehicle. Mobility within construction sites and across undeveloped ground is essential."

5. Add "Acceptable Experience and Training: Employee must have a high school diploma or GED, and a Kentucky driver's license. Prior experience in enforcement is desirable, but not required. Vehicle will be furnished by the Fiscal Court for and during normal business hours. Subject to criminal background check and/or drug testing. The workweek will consist of a maximum of 25 hours."

Section Two. Chapter Three Personnel Administration Plan II Classification Plan is hereby amended to create the job class title of "Recycling Center Supervisor" as class code 1017 with the following additions:

- 1. Add "Pay Grade: \$10.00-\$15.00/hr"
- Add "Characteristics of the Class: An employee of this class reports to the Superintendent of Buildings, Grounds and Other Properties (Superintendent) and is responsible for day to day operations and supervision of the Spencer County Recycling Center."
- 3. Add "Essential Job Functions: An employee in this position will supervise and oversee the regular operations of the recycling center. This will include but not necessarily limited to the scheduling and work flow of the recycling center as well as scheduling with recyclers for the pick-up of recyclable materials to be sold and picked up. The supervisor will insure that donated recyclable materials will be sorted into containers, recyclable items from county buildings, and public schools, are picked up on a regular and timely basis. Recyclables from other businesses may be picked up on request and in co-ordination with the Superintendent. The Supervisor will insure that routine cleaning of the recycling buildings grounds and simple maintenance tasks on recycling machines are accomplished."
- 4. Add "Job Related Physical Activity Requirements: This employee may be required to perform a variety of demanding physical agility tasks during the normal course of the job. The employee may be required to exert up to 50 pounds of force occasionally. Physical activity related to this position may include climbing, stooping, balancing, kneeling, crouching, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, fingering, grasping, talking, hearing, and repetitive motions. An employee in this position could reasonably anticipate exposure to indoor and outdoor environmental conditions."
- Add "Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Ability to perform extensive operations involved in recycling materials and maintain the buildings and grounds of the center with little or no supervision. Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions."

 Add "Acceptable Experience and Training: Completion of a standard high school course or G.E.D. or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities."

Section Three. All clerical/technical corrections are to be made in appropriate sections/index of the County Administrative Code to reflect the creation the positions as detailed in Section One and Section Two of this ordinance.
