

Special Called Meeting of the Spencer County Fiscal Court

Thursday, July 5, 2012, 11:00 am

Prayer before Court began

Esq. Judd led the Court in prayer.

Pledge of Allegiance

Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag.

Call to order by Spencer County Judge Executive, Bill Karrer

Roll call by Spencer County Clerk, Lynn Hesselbrock- Esq. Judd, Esq. Goodlett, County Judge Executive Bill Karrer, Esq. Davis present: Esq. Moody and Esq. Cheek absent.

The Judge explained that the Emergency Meeting was called to order because the vote on the second reading of passage of the Fiscal Year 2012/2013 Spencer County Budget was illegal, null and void because although there was a quorum of the Court, he found the Court needed to have a majority of all Court members vote for the budget and the vote at that time was three to two which was a majority of the court present, but was not a majority of the Court. It will take four "yes" votes to make a budget legal and because the Court is very early into the budgetary year, we do not have a budget, tomorrow is pay day. We will start paying out money out of the budget and the county needs to have one before that can happen, so the Judge said that he called this Emergency Meeting to revote the budget and He moved at that time to declare the meeting and Emergency Meeting.

- On the motion of County Judge Executive Bill Karrer, seconded by Esq. Judd, with Esq. Judd, Esq. Goodlett, Judge Karrer and Esq. Davis voting "Aye", and Esq. Moody and Esq. Cheek absent, this meeting is hereby ordered to constitute an Emergency Meeting.

Discussion ensued regarding the budget. The Judge stated he would move to pass the 2012/2013 budget as corrected in the minutes of the June 18, 2012 Fiscal Court meeting with corrections to the County Clerk's budget and to the Sheriff's budget.

Esq. Davis said "you know originally Esq. Moody and myself voted no for this. I mean in light of the employees not getting paid tomorrow and if this was a full Court it would have passed anyway, and I don't like this budget. And I see myself in the future

not voting for any amendments or any additions to any lines or any transfers, with that being said, you can go ahead and call for the vote." Esq. Judd asked if the budget had been tabled at one time, and the Judge responded, "yes."

- On the motion of Judge Karrer, seconded by Esq. Judd, with Esq. Judd, Esq. Goodlett, Judge Karrer, Esq. Davis voting "Aye", and Esq. Moody, and Esq. Cheek absent, it is hereby ordered to pass the 2012/2013 budget with a vote of four to zero.

• On the motion of Esq. Davis, seconded by Esq. Goodlett, with all members of the Court present voting "Aye", it is hereby ordered to adjourn this Emergency Meeting of Spencer County Court at 11:15 am.

61.823 Special meetings -- Emergency meetings.

- (1) Except as provided in subsection (5) of this section, special meetings shall be held in accordance with the provisions of subsections (2), (3), and (4) of this section.
- (2) The presiding officer or a majority of the members of the public agency may call a special meeting.
- (3) The public agency shall provide written notice of the special meeting. The notice shall consist of the date, time, and place of the special meeting and the agenda. Discussions and action at the meeting shall be limited to items listed on the agenda in the notice.
- (4)
 - (a) As soon as possible, written notice shall be delivered personally, transmitted by facsimile machine, or mailed to every member of the public agency as well as each media organization which has filed a written request, including a mailing address, to receive notice of special meetings. The notice shall be calculated so that it shall be received at least twenty-four (24) hours before the special meeting. The public agency may periodically, but no more often than once in a calendar year, inform media organizations that they will have to submit a new written request or no longer receive written notice of special meetings until a new written request is filed.
 - (b) A public agency may satisfy the requirements of paragraph (a) of this subsection by transmitting the written notice by electronic mail to public agency members and media organizations that have filed a written request with the public agency indicating their preference to receive electronic mail notification in lieu of notice by personal delivery, facsimile machine, or mail. The written request shall include the electronic mail address or addresses of the agency member or media organization.
 - (c) As soon as possible, written notice shall also be posted in a conspicuous place in the building where the special meeting will take place and in a conspicuous place in the building which houses the headquarters of the agency. The notice shall be calculated so that it shall be posted at least twenty-four (24) hours before the special meeting.
- (5) In the case of an emergency which prevents compliance with subsections (3) and (4) of this section, this subsection shall govern a public agency's conduct of a special meeting. The special meeting shall be called pursuant to subsection (2) of this section. The public agency shall make a reasonable effort, under emergency circumstances, to notify the members of the agency, media organizations which have filed a written request pursuant to subsection (4)(a) of this section, and the public of the emergency meeting. At the beginning of the emergency meeting, the person chairing the meeting shall briefly describe for the record the emergency circumstances preventing compliance with subsections (3) and (4) of this section. These comments shall appear in the minutes. Discussions and action at the emergency meeting shall be limited to the emergency for which the meeting is called.

67.077 Treatment of proposed ordinance -- Incorporation of material into ordinance by reference -- Section not applicable to charter county, urban-county government, or consolidated local government.

- (1) No county ordinance shall be passed until it has been read on two (2) separate days, but ordinances may be read by title and a summary only. A proposed ordinance may be amended by the fiscal court after its first reading and prior to its adoption. All amendments shall be proposed in writing, and only by setting out in full each amended section.
- (2) No county ordinance shall be passed until it has been published pursuant to KRS Chapter 424. Prior to passage, ordinances may be published by summary. Publication shall include the time, date, and place at which the county ordinance will be considered, and a place within the county where a copy of the full text of the proposed ordinance is available for public inspection. Publication of amendments to a proposed ordinance shall be required, pursuant to KRS Chapter 424, prior to its adoption, and amendments shall be filed with the full text of the proposed ordinance that is available for public inspection. If consideration for passage is continued from the initial meeting to a subsequent date, no further publication shall be necessary if at each meeting the time, date, and place of the next meeting are announced.
- (3) All county ordinances and amendments shall be published after passage and may be published in full or in summary form at the discretion of the fiscal court. If applicable, a sketch, drawing, or map, together with a narrative description written in layman's terms, may be used in lieu of metes and bounds descriptions. If published in summary form, publication shall contain notice of a place in the county where the full text of the ordinance or amendment is available for public inspection.
- (4) Traffic, building, housing, plumbing, electrical, safety, and other self-contained codes may be adopted by reference if a copy of the code is kept with the adopting ordinance and is made a part of the permanent records of the county.
- (5) The provisions of this section shall not be applicable in counties that have pursuant to KRS 67.830 adopted a charter county form of government or pursuant to KRS Chapter 67A adopted an urban-county form of government or pursuant to KRS Chapter 67C adopted a consolidated local government.

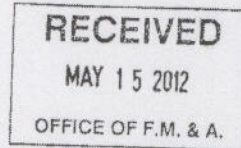

67.078 Quorum -- Majority of fiscal court required to pass ordinance -- Emergency acts -- Effective date.

- (1) Unless otherwise provided by statute, a majority of a fiscal court shall constitute a quorum and a majority of a quorum shall be sufficient to take action, except that a majority of the fiscal court shall be required to pass an ordinance. No meeting shall be held by the fiscal court without notice to all members thereof.
- (2) A majority of the fiscal court may declare an emergency to exist by naming and describing the emergency, and thereafter may adopt a county ordinance to address that emergency without regard to the requirements of KRS 67.077.
- (3) All county ordinances and other official actions shall state the effective date thereof.
