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SPENCER COUNTY FISCAL COURT MONDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2016, 7:00PM FISCAL COURT MEETING ROOM 28 EAST MAIN STREET MINUTES

- A. OPENING PRAYER
 - Esq. Judd led the Court in prayer before the call to order.
- B PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE U.S. AND KENTUCKY FLAGS
- C. CALL TO ORDER BY COUNTY JUDGE EXECUTIVE- JOHN RILEY
- D. ROLL CALL BY SPENCER COUNTY CLERK- LYNN HESSELBROCK- ALL PRESENT
- E. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES FROM PRIOR COURT MEETING
 - Motion made by Esq. Judd to approve the minutes from the meeting of 3 October, 2016, with any necessary changes and additions or deletions at the will of the Court. Motion was seconded by Esq. Williams. Discussion ensued with the Clerk and the Judge pointing out clerical errors on page one. The Judge stated that he had some other changes. He handed out four pages of proposed changes to the minutes. He said 'the first change pertains to item 1, under old business, page 6, that is I made mention of this at the last meeting, the meeting minutes were beginning to look like transcripts, and that's six pages almost of single spaced, of what appears to be a transcript. I don't know if everybody's had an opportunity to review that with the video that we have, but I propose changing that to, it's in your, what I passed out, under item 1, page 1,
 - 1) Cheryl Klotz Regarding Tanglewood Road

Mrs. Klotz came before the Court regarding her request to have the County take over a portion of Tanglewood Drive, currently a private road not in the county road system. A lengthy discussion ensued regarding the bond from many years ago and the problem of how to adopt these roads now without setting a precedent that would lead to many other requests for the county to adopt other private roads that do not meet the current county specifications.

The County Judge agreed to continue to explore the issue with Esq. Rogers, the County Aπorney and Mrs. Klotz.

Esq. Rogers suggested the property owners look into the services of a private contractor for maintenance and snow removal.

There was no resolution and no action was taken on this issue.

The Judge continued 'so I would move that we, or I would request that you strike the six pages and insert that.' Esq. Goodlett inquired if there was a motion for that and the Judge replied 'I would like that changed.' The Clerk explained that the reason that the minutes had become more like a transcript was that the Judge on several previous occasions had implied that the Clerk's minutes were not accurate and suggested the Magistrates 'look at the dvd'. She went on

that this was a very important topic, 'obviously, Ms. Klotz has been here several times, so I think in regards to transparency that people should be able to see this, people don't come here and get a dvd, so it should be in the minutes, so it should be recorded. So you are asking me to change the minutes that I took from the dvd' and the Judge interjected 'I am asking you, because we have, as everyone knows, the Department for Libraries and Archives, and I've also included this in your packet, came and did a workshop specifically for Spencer County, it wasn't particularly well attended, it was myself, Karen and Doug and Ken, and the issue came up with the minutes and I asked, you know, should they read like a transcript and they strongly recommended against that and I included in the packet I handed out the retention schedule information from the Department of Libraries and Archives, and if you go down to the, I highlighted it on mine, not on your alls, where it says 'Audio Video Recordings of Official Meetings....

L4940 Audio/Video Meetings

This record series documents the actual proceedings of public meetings held by any local government body or its entities. The audio tapes are generally used by the Recordings of Official recording secretary as a transcribing aid. The video tapes are generally made available to local access television stations for public broadcast. Minutes usually contain the date, time, place, attendance, approval of prior meeting's minutes, motions made, votes, and actions taken, however, according to KRS 61.835, minutes need only contain an accurate record of votes and actions. Because additional discussion need not be included as part of the official record, after the minutes are formally accepted at the following meeting, the tapes can be destroyed or used again.

Access Restrictions None

Contents This record series may contain. Audio/video recording of proceedings.

Retention and Disposition Destroy or re-use 30 days after minutes have been transcribed and approved, unless challenged. Note: If minutes are challenged, recordings should be retained until resolution.

61.835 Minutes to be recorded -- Open to public.

The minutes of action taken at every meeting of any such public agency, setting forth an accurate record of votes and actions at such meetings, shall be promptly recorded and such records shall be open to public inspection at reasonable times no later than immediately following the next meeting of the body.

History: Created 1974 Ky. Acts ch. 377, sec. 7.

The Judge continued 'however, according to KRS 61.835 which I also included in your packet there, minutes need only contain an accurate record of the votes and actions, so, we, they strongly recommended against that, we do have a video and audio recording of the meetings and I believe we started doing that back in June of 2010, and technically, yes, we could destroy those after 30 days, but we do not, and those are available, so when I tried to read through these, it was, I can see many areas where somebody could read these minutes and be very confused and I don't know if any of you have had a chance to read them, maybe if you have, maybe if you haven't, I certainly wouldn't vote to approve these minutes as they are written, but...' the Clerk asked ' so are you disputing anything in here that's not true?' and the Judge responded 'no, I'm just saying that I'm not..' and the Clerk stated 'then I'm not changing them' and the Judge said 'huh?' and the Clerk said 'I won't change them.' She went on 'so we want the minutes according to the Judge rather than what was actually said?' the Judge replied 'it would be, I really, according to the Department of Libraries and Archives, as a matter of fact, there's information in the packet, everybody's packet, there will be another workshop down at the KIPDA office, and I strongly urge you to go, but, these minutes could be extremely confusing

to someone trying to ascertain what is discussed. The purpose of the minutes are to record, I'll read it right off here, date time place attendance, approval of prior meeting's minutes, motions made, votes, and actions taken, however, according to KRS 61.835, minutes need only contain an accurate record of votes and actions taken. All this is far more than needs to be in the minutes, this is not an issue of, not one of transparency, anybody, any of us, and anyone from the public has access to the video and audio recordings of these meetings, and I think it's, we've got, just on that item alone, I've got others I'd like to be changed before we approve these minutes. That's six pages, single spaced, has everyone read that and compared it to the video?' Esq. Judd said he had read the minutes, but had not viewed the video. Esq. Williams asked the Judge if he had read the minutes and watched the video and the Judge replied 'no, I haven't, that's why I'm saying this is way too much. If there's gonna be a transcript of these meetings, then we need to have a court, a certified court reporter, so that we know, for certain, that these are an accurate reflection of what was discussed. I don't think that's necessary, audio and video record these meetings, and I want to strongly object to the minutes written the way they are.' Esq. Judd said 'if there had been an accurate accounting of the minutes, with the situation with Ms. Klotz, then we wouldn't have a question. It would give you a trail as to what took place, and right now there is so much stuff missing, and that's what you're willing to take out of the minutes, something that might be important to someone who wasn't here at Court that night.' The Judge replied 'well I think what I recommended is...' Esq. Judd continued 'I'm strongly against it, amending the minutes' and the Judge said 'okay, I respect that' and the Judge went on 'what I have suggested as a change accurately reflects what we did on that issue. Anyone who wants further detail on it can always look at the audio and video recording.' The Clerk said that 'Julie told me that those recordings are erased after a period of time' the Judge interjected 'they are erased but we keep them on a dvd, they are stored' and the Clerk said that she thought 'Julie did not do a dvd unless somebody requested it' the Judge said 'they are held on dvd.' The Judge continued 'I'll move on to my next recommended change, is under item 2, Sheriff office mold issue, and we've got, what appears to be a transcript, you know, and I've recommended a change, you all have got it in your packet I handed out, do you want me to read that to you, or, it is an accurate reflection of what happened at the meeting,' Esq. Goodlett asked if the minutes were the ones the Judge had handed out and the Judge replied they were. The Judge went on 'I recommend that change before these are approved' Esq. Judd asked why the Judge's changes were not in the packets so that the magistrates could have looked over them prior to the meeting and the Judge replied 'the minutes, well we did not get until, I think, until sometime around 3:30 or so on Thursday afternoon. As you know, we have the packets ready by noon on Friday, so there wasn't enough time for me to even, uh, in fact I came in and worked yesterday to try to go through this, uh, you know.' The Judge asked Esq. Judd 'have you had a chance to really go ...' and Esq. Judd said he had read through the minutes, but did not have the Judge's changes. The Judge continued 'the next change that I'm recommending, and again is in your packet that I handed out, would be under item 4, under item 4, new business, as it pertains to salary adjustments.' 'You certainly can, if you'd like, just to vote this down, and take it up at the next meeting when everybody's had a chance to compare what I've recommended versus to what was presented.' Esq. Judd said 'personally Judge I think it's a bad idea because it boils down to you interpreting what you think should be in the minutes and what she actually took down.' 'So for someone on the Court, I'd like to know exactly what took

place, not what you think was said.' The Judge replied, 'this is just not me, okay, this is on the recommendation of the Department of Libraries and Archives, so I wish you would have been able to attend the workshop, I know you probably had something else going, but, there is another workshop, actually it's right behind your agenda in the book, November 3rd, at the KIPDA office. I would encourage all of you, if you can, to attend that. The Judge continued 'Squire, it's entirely up to you whether you want to go ahead and approve, vote yea on this motion, or we can vote it down and take it up at the next meeting. Esq. Williams suggested the Court vote on the matter. Esq. Goodlett said that there was a motion and a second and Judge Riley said 'we've got a motion and a second' and Esq. Williams called for the vote. The Judge said,' all right call for the vote.' Esq. Goodlett clarified, call for the vote to approve the minutes... and Judge Riley interjected 'to approve the minutes as, well, I'm recommending the changes, but the motion was with changes, so I recommended some changes and, we can adopt those or not.' Esq. Williams said 'so a yes vote would mean to adopt them just like they read now, correct?' Judge Riley responded 'uh, a yes vote will be to adopt them as they were presented, a no would be to reject the changes and we can take it up at the next meeting.' Esq. Williams said 'okay' The Clerk began to call the roll on the vote and Esq. Judd said 'now we're just voting on the minutes, not the changes that you're recommending, and the Judge interjected 'or any of the changes' Esq. Judd responded 'the administrative changes to it, yes, I could see where we need to approve those, but not the page, the packet you have given us Judge' Judge Riley continued 'I recommended changes..." Esq. Williams said the motion was to approve the minutes as presented, and Esq. Judd said that he thought the motion included the changes that the Judge wanted made. Esq. Williams said that was not the case and Judge Riley said 'if you'd like to withdraw the motion, and we'll consider a new motion. Are you prepared to do that?' Esq. Judd said he would. The Judge said it was Esq. Judd's motion, and asked him if he wanted to withdraw it, and Esq. Judd answered in the affirmative. Esq. Judd said he moved the minutes...and the Judge interjected 'let's deal with the first motion we've got on the floor, are we gonna withdraw that?' Esq. Judd said that he had not made the motion and Judge Riley said that he thought Esq. Judd had made the motion, and Esq. Williams said that he had seconded it. Discussion continued with the Judge saying 'Clerk, who made the motion?' The Clerk responded that Esq. Judd made the motion to approve the minutes as presented, and Esq. Williams indicated that they were not voting on the Judge's changes, just the minutes as presented. The Judge said to Esq. Judd, 'so your motion is to accept the minutes as presented without changes' and Esq. Judd clarified administrative or clerical changes were to be made. The Judge said that he would accept spelling corrections. And Esq. Judd clarified his motion to approving the minutes with spelling and clerical changes being made and Esq. Williams said his second still stood. 'ayes' were Esq. Williams, Esq. Goodlett, Esq. Bayers and Esq. Judd. 'nays' were Judge Riley and Esq. Rogers. Motion carries. The Judge stated 'well I'm gonna, for the record please note, that I strongly object to minutes reading like transcripts, unless we're gonna...'

F. COMMUNICATIONS FROM CITIZENS ***3 MINUTE LIMIT***

1. Mr. John Thompson came before the Court to ask that a County Road, Hall Road, be closed to public traffic.

Proposal to close Hall Rd spencer Co. Ky.

Oct. 17,

2016

To Spencer County Fiscal Court,

I, John N. Thompson, would like to have Hall Road closed off. Which is at my property line. It is 691.09 feet from Highway 44. See deed book 90, page 347. Last surveyed 11/25/2013. The road goes to nowhere. The only maintenance done by the county is leveling out in the front and grass cutting on both sides of the road on my property. Over the last 25 months, I have had over 75 people trespass on my property from the road, these include hunters, cement trucks, personal vehicles, atvs, horse riders, walkers. Etc. People who have no business on my property. I have had personal property stolen from my property. There is lots of trash, tires etc. left from before I purchased the property. Planning and Zoning Julie Sweazy cannot issue me a property address or number until this issue is resolved.

If road is not to be closed, repairs will have to be made. So closing the road would be a cost saver to the county.

I have spoken with the following persons about this situation; Julie Sweazy, Planning and Zoning, My Magistrate David Goodlett, Judge-Executive John Riley and County Road Department Foreman Todd Burch.

Mr. Thompson said several vehicles had been on his property and left garbage behind. He also had items stolen from his property. He said that he owned the property for approximately 25 months and the road went nowhere. Mr. Thompson said that Julie in Planning and Zoning could not give him a number until this issue was resolved. The Judge said this time was for public discussion and that it was not an item on the agenda, so there would not be much discussion on the matter. The Judge said he would refer the issue to Esq. Goodlett, the County Attorney. Discussion continued with no resolution.

- 2. An individual came forward and the Judge asked him to state his name and the individual stated 'it's not required per the Open Records Act. The individual said 'Counselor Jones, I'm directing this towards you. I have come before this agency and asked them why it is that in the County Administrative Code under ordinance that it is required that they seek out the SOPs from the Spencer County Sheriff's office and contained within those SOPs there should be specific regulations or procedures on the use of County owned vehicles that are leased or allowed to be used by the Sheriff. And yet, they never have. So I'm to conclude that Sheriff Buddy Stump is in essence, a thief and stealing public funds. The Judge said 'you know I'm not gonna tolerate that' and the individual said 'okay, that's fine, whatever' and the Judge replied 'no personal attacks' The individual went on to say 'once again, Counselor Jones, Dubarry, a former deputy, John Dubarry, I've documented with pictures, that he was in downtown Louisville during the NRA convention performing security services for a private company, and making the money on the side. Taxpayer's money, in Spencer County, used for that car, gas and the equipment. And just two weeks ago, I'm getting reports that a special deputy, he's an attorney for the city of Louisville, Ron Schwoeppe, he's driving a Spencer County Sheriff's vehicle, coming off of 64, on the Taylorsville Road, lights and siren, passing people, you've even got tractor trailers that he's passing, but when I call Major Reesor, Major Reesor said ahh, well the paperwork fell in the middle of the console and turned them on, but I've got eyewitnesses that say different to that. Schwoeppe tells an agent working for me in the Sheriff's office, that Buddy Stump allowed him to use the vehicle for personal use because his car was broke down. The need and necessity for him to be back to meet Gary Day at 4:30 because this happened between 4 and 4:15 on Taylorsville Road. Why are we allowing a Sheriff's deputy, a special deputy, to have a car in Jefferson County for his personal use. Any yet Stump comes in and he wants body armor of all things. A man that's not even providing 24/7 coverage. He gives a man an \$18,000.00 raise, and instead of being out there patrolling, he's sitting on his behind.' The Judge struck the gavel on the table and said 'I'm not gonna tolerate personal attacks' The individual said 'that's not a personal attack, John.' The individual continued 'if these 4 deputies that Buddy claims in his lawsuit about this mold are truly affected by it, then I think the taxpayers of the County need to have the records stating that, otherwise, it's bullshit.' The Judge said' ah, excuse me, we're not gonna tolerate that..' the individual continued 'and I wanna know one other thing...' and the Judge interjected 'your time is up, sir' and the individual said 'you let
- 3. Mr. Grant Riggs came before the Court. He said that he just wanted to say that this was the first time he had come to Court, and he said it kind of blew his mind. He said 'government in action, why we can't get anything done.' Mr. Riggs continued 'Ms. Hasselback, I think your minutes are fine, keep on doing what you're doing, as long as I can pick it up and read it, I could care less what format it's in.' 'but the real thing is that we need, unlike the previous speaker, I believe, and I want 24 hour Sheriff patrol coverage, I do. And I think, that at this time, you all have got the perfect window of opportunity to do that. Folks, violent crime is on the rise. Heroin overdoses are everywhere, and until it effects each and everyone of you personally, at that point in time, I think maybe you all would have a different out take on this. So I implore you to fund the Sheriff's office. I work a lot of times at night, I'd like to be able to know my wife could

Officer.' The Judge said 'I'm gonna call you out of order'

pick up the phone with two small children, and call, and there's a deputy working in Spencer County. Folks, the State Police Post Four covers seven counties, that Trooper may be on the other side of Franklin County, and when it's a violent felony offense, like what happened in Bullitt County, where people got home invaded, that individual was apprehended a short time later. Folks, put egos aside, put party differences aside. If Mr. Coulter was running for Sheriff, and he was sitting where Buddy Stump is, I would be up here saying the same thing. This isn't a democrat or republican thing, this is s safety thing. And whenever your family is adversely affected by violent crime in the community or heroin, where the Sheriff's office may have Narcan, and be able to save someone you love, at 3:30, 4:00, 5:00 in the morning, folks, you can't put a price on that. I implore you find a way to fund the Sheriff's office. And take care of the people who work in these public buildings. Folks, I guarantee you that if there was mold in this building, we wouldn't be having this meeting here, would we? It would be getting fixed, we'd be somewhere else. We have got to care about our people; not only the people who live in the County, but the people who work for us and do a public service, as well. We have got to put those differences aside, I implore you to fund the Sheriff's office. I sleep better at night, my family does, knowing that it's a phone call away. Knowing that they have that extra coverage, that somebody will be there, not an hour, two hours. So please, parties aside, egos aside, let's fund the Sheriff's office, and get them the tools they need, resolve this mold issue, because you're going to pay more in a class action lawsuit than you will to fix the problem. Fix the problem. Let's get that done. And then that way we can all move on. But we've got to care about our people, folks, I hope you all will care about me, I pay taxes, I expect a certain amount of services, and you cannot put a dollar amount on public safety. You cannot put a dollar amount on a human life. And God forbid, if one of your all's family member was in dire straights, and needs a Sheriff's Deputy, there's one that's going to be there. So please, let's do the right thing, and let's take care of those that take care of us. Thank you all.'

H. COMMUNICATIONS/REPORTS FROM MEMBERS, OTHER OFFICES AND COMMITTEES

Zoning readings and recommendations.
 There were no zoning readings.

Solid Waste committee

Esq. Judd said that he had spoken with Mr. Curtis Ochs and Ms. Karen Spencer about an illegal dump located on the Hume property on 44 West. Ms. Lynn McAllister from the Louisville EPA office was going to meet with the Solid Waste committee on Friday and Esq. Judd said he would update the Court after the meeting and the Judge said he would be in attendance at the meeting also. Esq. Judd said that there was an extra baler in use at the Recycling Center. Sign ups for the highway cleanup project would be starting and the groups had until the end of November to finish with the clean up on the roadways.

Veteran's committee

Esq. Judd said the committee met last week, and they would meet again next week. The War memorial has not had any work done yet, the nameplates of several individuals had come off, they were given to Mr. Randy Bush who had put them back up. Esq. Judd said the back side of the Memorial was deplorable and Mr. Joe Goodlett had volunteered to take care of the problem. Esq. Judd said the Veteran's Day ceremony would take place on November 5, 2016 where everyone would assemble at the Chamber at 10:00 am and then have the ceremony afterwards.

Buildings and Grounds committee

Esq. Williams said he had nothing to add. Judge Riley said that he would add something. The Judge said that the west wall of the building that his office was in had a real issue. He said it would need to be addressed at some point. Esq. Williams asked if that was the wall that the old building was torn down and the Judge replied that it was. He encouraged the magistrates to go and take a look at the wall. The Judge said that the Court would also need to look at the box guttering. The Judge said that the Court had initially got a price to fix the gutters but AOC required an additional three bids. The Judge said that there were not many people who worked on that type of gutters as the proper way to restore them would be to line them with copper and the one quote they had received was somewhere around \$24,000.00. He said that AOC might pay for a portion of the cost.

Administrative code committee

Esq. Williams said he was not able to attend the last meeting due to medical issues. He said Esq. Bayers chaired the meeting. Esq. Bayers said that there was further discussion and some new information was passed on to the County Attorney.

Esq. Judd asked the Judge if he had skipped the Equipment committee. The Judge said that he had. Esq. Goodlett said that there was nothing to report. The Judge said he would add something to the Equipment committee. The Judge said the Court would really need to take a look at tractors and mowers for the Road Department. He said that they had been plagued with problems and they would have to look at replacing that equipment hopefully before Spring. Esq. Williams asked that the Equipment committee could look at sub- contracting out the mowing. The Judge said that he wasn't sure that that would fall under the Equipment committee. The Judge said Esq. Williams was free to look at that and bring some suggestions back to the Court.

OLD BUSINESS

Sheriff building

a) Jonathan Saunders and Becky Konemann, CIMR Tech presentation.

Mr. Saunders said he was asked to come to Court based on a product that they sold. He said his company dealt with purification systems for air. He said it was an air sanitization system. He said he would give a basic overview of the product because many people had not yet heard of the product. He went on that the company had spent the last ten years primarily in government contract work, but that the company was now wanting to branch out to private industry. Mr. Saunders said that he worked for a company called CIMR Tech which was owned by Hi-Tech Air and Water Purifications Systems, Inc. out of Silsbee, Texas. He said that he joined the company

about six months prior and had known the owner for about twelve years. He said the owner had done much work for the military at Fort Hood in Texas. Mr. Saunders said that he had seen the product work and that he believed in the product and that air purification had global implications. He said that there were two types of air sanitization systems, passive systems and active systems. Passive systems would be like HEPA filters; they are passive because air has to get to the system for the air to get sanitized. He said that UV lights would be a type of passive system. Mr. Saunders said that there were two types of active systems; one was a system using ozonators. He said this system pushed ozone out into the environment. He said that this sanitizes the air in the area the unit is in and it has been around for a while, and it had to work slowly because high ozone levels could be unsafe and leave an odor. He said the system he was representing used hydrogen peroxide gas and was an active system that 'takes the hydrogen and oxygen that is naturally occurring in the air and in the moisture, and then it pulls it into the system and then it combines it through a photo catalytic process, that just means that there is a bulb in there, so a fan will pull it through there, it crosses the bulb, and it turns it into H2O2, which is hydrogen peroxide. Hydrogen peroxide is earth's natural sterilant.' He said his product achieved 98% kill rates on MRSA, Staph, Listeria, mold and allergens. He went on to describe how the product worked. He said there was no odor, no taste, and that it was perfectly safe. He said the hydrogen peroxide came out at .02 PPM, which was one fiftieth of what OSHA considered safe. He said the system was similar to an ozonator in that it would sanitize the air first and then sanitize anything it came in contact with such as pathogens, viruses, bacteria, mold, allergens. He went on to say that they had two different units, one was a portable unit, and the other worked through the HVAC system. He said that there were two portable units presently in the Sheriff's office. The HVAC system came in sizes to be used according to the square footage of the area to be sanitized. The units designed to be used with the HVAC system worked from 1500 square feet up to 8,000 square feet. This will sanitize the air in the air ducts first, then it would work its way out to the rest of the environment. So it would come out of the air vent then it would sanitize the entire room and then it will begin to work on all the surfaces, and then over time, it will go into every nook and cranny in that building. The speed at which that happens depends on the size of the unit. He said that for the Sheriff's office, they were recommending to put in two 8,000 square foot units for a very quick return and a very fast notice in the air quality in the building. He said that they were looking at 24 to 48 hours with that much 'horsepower' going on in that building you'd see a difference in the air quality. He said all the research that has been done on this product has been done by Kansas State University. He then presented a slide with 'before' and 'after' pictures of several areas that had used the product with an apparent removal of mold. He said that his product would make it possible to salvage any furniture in the building. He said his product turned the mold into a fine dust that can then be vacuumed up. He said that his company was able to save the artifacts at Spindletop Museum in Texas. The Judge said that he had become aware of this technology and had met with Mr. Saunders and was very impressed with this product and personally purchased two of the portable units. He said a copy of the invoice was in the magistrate's packet. He said he would like to get reimbursement for the units. He said that he 'personally paid for those units to get them in, we overnighted them and got them in on Thursday; there are two of these currently working since Thursday, I don't know what time we put them in around 1:00 or 1:30 Thursday afternoon, so they have been working in the first floor of the Sheriff's office since

then, and I've not been in there, and I know you'd like to go in and take a look at...those portable units are not going to be completely effective on what he's talking about...' Mr. Saunders interjected 'the portable units will handle the immediate area they're in. from my understanding, it's been like six months, I would imagine that there is probably stuff up in the air handler, and that stuff has to get taken care of; the air handler is just going to be recirculating that mess, anything that is in there. Which is why I am highly recommending the ductwork system, it will sanitize the ductwork first and then our unit, our ductwork units are much larger than the portable units, much more horsepower, so the portable units are temporary at best, it would not be a permanent solution.' The Judge said 'then they can be moved to other offices' and Mr. Saunders replied 'yes, sir' The Judge asked if anyone had any questions. Esq. Goodlett asked what the lifespan of the unit was and Mr. Saunders replied' we have yet to, most the, we have never gone out completely on us, it's outliving us currently. We have a five year warranty on it, we'll replace it for free, up to five years, it should last the life of that HVAC unit. It should, especially on the HVAC unit, there's no moving parts on that thing, it should last the life of that HVAC unit.' The Judge said that Mr. Saunders had pointed out to him that a bulb might go bad, and that was covered for five years. Mr. Saunders said that the bulb was the heart and soul of the unit, that it was only a bulb and was usually only an issue on the portable units, that are being plugged and unplugged several times. Discussion continued. Ms. Becky Konemann came before the Court. She is a Spencer County resident and spoke of her personal experience with the CIMR Tech unity. Her husband was diagnosed with brain cancer 18 months earlier, and has since passed in August. She said one of the things that she had done was research on alternative treatments to combat common problems associated with chemotherapy's side effects. She said that she had purchased a portable unit and kept in their bedroom as her husband was pretty much immobile, to keep infections away because cancer patients are prone to infections because of their lowered immune systems. She said that she was very pleased because he never did get an infection. The Judge asked if there were any more questions and said 'it's a pretty fascinating piece of equipment here that could possibly solve our problem, hopefully the two portable units that have been in there working since Thursday have had significant impact; I have not been in there, I don't know, Sheriff can you make the building available after the meeting?' and the Sheriff responded in the affirmative. The Judge said that he thought the Court would be interested in the pricing. The DW400 unit sells for \$2999.00. The DW800 is normally \$3725.00, but Mr. Saunders said that the company would offer a discount and sell the two 8000 units for the price of a 4000 unit for a total of approximately \$6,000.00 for two units. The Judge said that Mr. Saunders also mentioned another device for continuous monitoring. Mr. Saunders replied that his company could offer air monitoring, it monitors the quality of the air on a consistent basis. He said the best readings would be obtained when there are not doors opening and shutting frequently. Best readings are obtained in the morning. The unit looks like a thermostat and gives you the temperature, time and measures the particulates, particles in the air which would be your hazards like mold, and things of that nature. It will give you a reading of high, medium or low. The cost of the monitoring is \$1,000.00 for 90 days of monitoring and there would be no charge on the installation. He said that they could monitor exactly what bacteria was present and how much of it was present. The Judge said that he thought if the Court were to purchase the units, that they might want the industrial hygienist to come back and do some sampling. Mr. Saunders said that

the industrial hygienist's results would be much more detailed than their monitoring system, which he described as 'generic.' Mr. Saunders said the maximum cost of installation of the CIMR Tech units would be \$120.00 and would take only 15 minutes. The Judge said 'I personally think it's worth a try. We've got estimates in excess of \$120,000.00 to tear out drywall and do all kinds of stuff. I believe this would be well worth a try and it's going to be up to the Court, but it sure would beat the alternative if this works. Which brings me to the fact the company also will 100% guarantee that it works, and if we're not satisfied, they will take them back and refund our money. That's important to know,' The Judge asked if anyone had questions and Esq. Bayers inquired as to if the hygienist had been consulted to see what their thoughts on the product were. The Judge said that OSHA had been in and they were not familiar with the technology. The Judge said after he had met with Mr. Saunders he went home and his wife, who worked at the Brown Cancer Center said she was familiar with the product and said 'oh yes, hospitals use that' Mr. Saunders said that the technology was not new, but was limited in its' scope being used mostly by the military. Discussion continued on the size of the unit that would best suit the needs of the Sheriff's office. Esq. Judd asked Mr. Saunders how soon after installation of the larger units, could the building be occupied and Mr. Saunders responded 'immediately' Mr. Saunders corrected himself and said 'from 24 to 48 hours.' The Judge said that the two units he had purchased were placed in the front 'patrol room' and in the west entrance area, covering the reception area. Esq. Bayers asked if the product would turn the black mold brown and Mr. Saunders said when the mold was killed it would turn into a fine powder and could be vacuumed up. Esq. Bayers asked if they could go in the building and actually see it work and Mr. Saunders said "personally, I did not see any mold. I'm not a licensed mold technician.' The Judge said 'if it's there, it's going to get it, as well as viruses or bacteria or whatever.' Mr. Saunders went on 'I'm not a mold remediator, I sell a product and it sanitizes the air, it sanitizes the air and it sanitizes the surface.' The Judge went on 'I'd say you might be taking some market share from mold remediators' and Mr. Saunders replied' we work with them.' The Judge asked if any certification was needed to go in and clean up after his product turned the mold into a fine powder and Mr. Saunders replied it depended on each State's laws and he was not familiar with Kentucky's laws in regards to this matter. Mr. Saunders said that mold remediators bought and used his product. The Judge said the Court needed to 'make a decision, if anybody would, I'd entertain a motion if anybody would like to make a motion to go ahead and purchase two of the DW8000 at a cost of \$6,000.00 and that includes the shipping and then we would have to consider the installation which would be minimal, again with a 100% money back guarantee including the cost of installation and the company is pretty confident in their product to offer that.' 'It could actually solve our problem at the absolute least expense of tearing out walls and all that. There may be some, obviously, some cleaning involved as well, but the main thing is that it is going to make the environment safe, and that's why I went on and had those air freighted in to get them immediately working.' Esq. Bayers said 'my concern is the industrial hygienist recommended remediation and this is not remediation. Despite the good deal, I think I need more research before I can even make a decision on spending \$6,000.00, I don't know enough about the technology.' The Judge said 'that's the good part of the guarantee that they offer, if your concern is that it would not work...' and Esq. Rogers said 'we'd get our money back' and the Judge said 'there's no risk.' Discussion continued about the cost of remediation and the possible cost of cleaning after the product was installed. Mr. Saunders said the owner of the

company would be willing to speak with the members of the Court via Skype. He said the owner would be able to answer any technical questions. The Judge asked that with the product only being used with the military the DOD and Homeland Security, is it common that people are not familiar with the product, even industrial hygienists. Mr. Saunders said that had been the company's biggest hurdle. Discussion ensued. Esq. Judd said he would like to hear from some of the references the company had. The Judge said that the two portable units had been working since Thursday and he had no doubt that they had had significant affect on the first floor. The Judge continued 'I would personally would, with the guarantee they're offering and so forth, I don't see this as a huge financial risk, and if you look at the other side of it, the cost of not going with this technology, would be many many more times than this. We don't meet but the first and third Mondays of the month, unless you call a special meeting, which I suppose we could do, next week you all have a chance to check it out, we could do that. I would prefer not to delay and go on and get it in, you know, get it working in both the upstairs and the downstairs, not just the downstairs, and let it start working inside the HVAC system themselves which is what this will do versus the portable. Eventually it's going to get into the HVAC system, the portable, but it's just a much much slower process, particularly if you've got a door that you're exposed to the outdoor.' Mr. Saunders again said he would like to get the Court together with the owner who would be able to answer better than himself. The Judge again said he would prefer not to delay and he would entertain a motion to go ahead and purchase two of the DW 8000 units at a cost of \$6,000.00.

• Motion made by Esq. Rogers, seconded by Esq. Goodlett to purchase two DW 8000 units for the price of \$6,000.00. Lengthly discussion followed about the effectiveness of the technology and Esq. Williams questioned the use of the air scrubbers that had been purchased, but appeared to not be effective. The Judge said that the air scrubbers were meant to be a temporary solution while the Sheriff collected taxes and until the Court could decide what to do on a permanent basis. Esq. Williams also stated that the industrial hygienist had recommended against cutting holes in the drywall. Esq. Judd asked the Judge if he had spoken with the Sheriff about this and the Judge replied 'the Sheriff has not been very talkative as of late, I think that there is a considerable amount of skepticism with anything other than a move up to another facility' and Esq. Judd said that he had always heard that if something sounds too good to be true, that it probably was. Esq. Rogers replied 'money back guarantee' Esq. Bayers called for a vote on the motion. 'ayes' were Judge Riley, Esq. Goodlett and Esq. Rogers. 'nays' were Esq. Judd, Esq. Williams and Esq. Bayers. Motion fails.

The Judge said that there was an invoice in the magistrate's packets for the two CIMR Tech DW 4000 units that he had purchased and he wanted the Court to reimburse him for the purchase. He said he would entertain a motion to reimburse the Judge \$2690.00.

- Motion made by Esq. Goodlett, seconded by Esq. Rogers to proceed to lease 80 East Main Street on a temporary month to month basis to house the Sheriff's office for \$900.00 per month. 'ayes' were Judge Riley, Esq. Bayers, Esq. Rogers and Esq. Goodlett. 'nays' were Esq. Judd and Esq. Williams. Motion carries.

Motion made by Esq. Judd, seconded by Esq. Rogers, with all members of the Court present voting 'aye', it is hereby ordered to approve the purchase a 2017 Expedition for \$31,624.00 plus \$4,136.59 plus the cost of striping up to the cost of \$37,000.00.

new vehicle for the emergency management/ems director. The Judge suggest that perhaps the funds to pay for the new vehicle may come from funds budgeted for a new vehicle for the Sheriff's Department. He also said the loan from KACO could be modified if the Court chose to go in that direction.
